## TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR RECLAIMED WATER USE

CAUTION: Type II Reclaimed Water can only be used in remote, restricted, controlled or limited-access areas where human access is restricted or unlikely to occur Improper use or handling of Reclaimed Water is harmful and dangerous. Please read all terms and conditions carefully.

DO NOT USE RECLAIMED WATER FOR DRINKING, BATHING OR PERSONAL HYGEINE.

DO NOT USE RECLAIMED WATER FOR WASHING VEHICLES, CLOTHES OR OTHER PERSONAL CONTACT ITEMS.

DO NOT USE RECLAIMED WATER IN SWIMMING POOLS OR FOR ANY RECREATIONAL USES.

DO NOT ALLOW PERSONS OR ANIMALS TO CONTACT GRASS WET WITH RECLAIMED WATER.

DO NOT USE RECLAIMED WATER WHICH HAS BEEN STORED FOR MORE THAN 4 HOURS UNLESS THE CHLORINE RESIDUAL LEVEL HAS BEEN TESTED AND IS NOT LESS THAN ONE PART PER MILLION.

APPLICATION OF RECLAIMED WATER MUST BE BY COARSE STREAM AND NOT BY FINE SPRAY.

Do not apply the Reclaimed Water when the ground is water saturated or frozen.

Do not use Reclaimed Water to irrigate food crops that may be consumed raw by humans.

Do not discharge Reclaimed Water into waters of the State.

There shall be no Nuisance conditions resulting from use of the Reclaimed Water. "Nuisance" means any distribution, storage, or use of reclaimed water, in such concentration and of such duration that is or may tend to be injurious to or which adversely affects human health or welfare, animal life, vegetation, or property, or which interferes with normal use and enjoyment of animal life, vegetation, or property. Post signs in both English and Spanish at any Reclaimed Water storage areas, hose bibs, and faucets reading: "DANGER: RECLAIMED WATER, DO NOT DRINK."

Any container used to receive and transport the Reclaimed Water must have a lid or cap, be watertight, and be properly secured to the vehicle.

All containers are subject to inspection and approval of Corpus Christi Water.

Reclaimed Water must be immediately transported and used for purpose authorized in the permit. Reclaimed Water may not be stored for future use. Failure to immediately use the Reclaimed Water may result in growth of bacteria in the Reclaimed Water which may cause harm to myself and/or others who come into contact with the Reclaimed Water.
