JUROR'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Rights to Reemployment: A private employer may not terminate the employment of a permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror. An employee whose employment is terminated in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employee actual

Failure to Answer Summons and Provisions of False Information: Any person summoned who fails to attend or who fails to remain in attendance until discharged by the Court may be fined an amount not to exceed \$100 for contempt (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 45.027). Additionally, a person shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 if the person: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to the notice without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service (Government Code, Section 62.111). Furthermore, if a person knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption to be excused from jury service, the person is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine not less than \$100 or more than \$1,000 (Government Code, Section 62.0140).

Proper Clothing Required: All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonably befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings.

Exempt or Disqualified: You **do not need to appear** in person if you are exempt or not qualified for jury service. To claim an exemption or report your disqualification you must complete the following form below, sign it and mail it, email it to MCJury@cctexas.com, or

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE (Govt. Code Section 62.102 except where noted)	EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY SERVICE* (Govt. Code Section 62.106)
<p>To serve as a juror you <i>must</i> meet qualifications:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. be at least 18 years of age; 2. be a citizen of the United States; 3. be a citizen of this state and a resident of the city of Corpus Christi in which you are to serve as a juror; 4. be qualified under the Constitution and laws to vote in the county in which you are to serve as a juror (<i>Note: you DO NOT have to be registered to vote to be qualified to vote</i>); 5. be of sound mind and good moral character; 6. be able to read and write in English; 7. not have served as a juror for six days during the preceding three months in the county court or during the preceding six months in the district court; 8. not have been convicted of theft (misdemeanor or felony) or any felony; and 9. not be under indictment or other legal accusation of a misdemeanor theft, felony theft, or any other felony charge. 	<p>You may claim an exemption from jury service if you: (Check appropriate box)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you are over 70 years of age Date of Birth: ___/___/___;</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you have legal custody of a child or children younger than 12 years of age and service on the jury would require leaving the child or children without adequate supervision;</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you are a student at a public or private high school Name of school _____ Location of school _____ ;</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you are enrolled and in actual attendance at an institution of higher education Name of school _____ Location of school _____ ;</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you are an officer or an employee of the senate, the house of representatives, or any department, commission, board, office, or other agency in the legislative branch of state government;</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> you are the primary caretaker of a person who is unable to care for himself or herself.
