Mobile food vending units operating within the city limits of Corpus Christi must obtain a Health Permit and a Street Vending Permits. Both Permits can be obtained at the:

Vending Permit

Fee: \$120 per year

Requirements:

- 1. General comprehensive liability insurance naming the City of Corpus Christi as additional insured: \$1,000,000 per person, per occurrence and property damage.
- 2. Current Texas State Sales Tax Certificate -State Comptroller, 400 Mann Street, Ste 600 (361) 882-1234
- 3. Current Assumed Name Certificate (DBA) -County Clerk's Office Located at the Nueces County Courthouse (361) 888 -0580
- 4. Current state vehicle license and state inspection sticker
- 5. Complete application at the Environmental & Consumer Health Division during time of appointment
- 6. Photo of vehicle - will be taken at Environmental & Consumer Health Division
- 7. Background Checks are required for all Mobile Vendors wanting to conduct business within the City of Corpus Christi. Must go through a 3rd Party agency and agency must email results to us directly at ccenvo.admin@cctexas.com or in sealed envelope.
- 8. Food Trucks must have water in tanks, thermometers in all coolers/freezer and generator during inspection. (No Power Source Available at Health Dept.)

***Must have permanent license plate upon inspection*
(Temporary Tags are not allowed.)**

Fire Inspection

A Fire Department inspection will be required to be Completed if the vending unit has one or more of the following but not limited to:

- Propane/ propane piping.
- Solid fuels such as wood or charcoal are used
- Exposed surface cooking. **Fire Inspection Frost bank Building (3rd floor)**

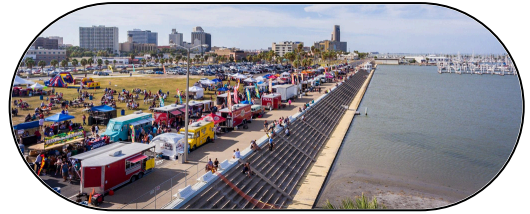

GUIDELINES FOR MOBILE FOOD VENDING



FOOD TRUCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SELL AT RESIDENTIAL HOMES

Mobile Unit

- Unit will be fully enclosed with any outer openings protected by mesh screen, self-closing door and serving window must be provided.
- Floors, walls, ceiling and attached equipment should be constructed of smooth and cleanable surface.
- All lighting should have shield fixtures.
- Equipment adequate to maintain products temperature.

Documents

- Certified Food Manager must be onsite at all times and all employees need Food Handler cards.
- Food product obtained from an approved source.
- Potable water from an approved source.

Equipments & Supplies

- Three compartment sink. (The sink must be large enough to wash the biggest piece of equipment used.)
- Separate hand washing sink must be installed and conveniently located and accessible.
- Soap, paper towels, detergent and sanitizing chemicals provide and stored in a safe place away from food products.
- Hot and cold running water with pressure at all sinks.
- Liquid Waste Retention tank provided and Capacity at least 15% larger than the potable water storage tank, permanently installed, sloped to drain and labeled "waste water."
- Potable water distribution pipes or tubing constructed and installed

Fire

- Mobile units must have a suppression system if cooking with open flame (system must meet Fire Marshal requirements)
- Generator must be used to provide electricity to mobile unit.
- Food Trucks must have water in tanks, thermometers in all coolers/freezer and generator during inspection (No Power Source Available at Health Dept)
